




REPORT OF ISR ACTIVITY OF DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHOLOGY

- A. Title of the activity:** Fund-raising event for Army Connect project of SIES management

2. Adopting 32 kids in Jamshet, Palghar and paying the salary of the teacher who teaches them

The thought behind sponsoring the salary of a teacher in the rural sector was rooted in the belief that education is a fundamental right and a powerful catalyst for social and economic development. Recognizing the challenges faced by rural communities in accessing quality education, the initiative aimed to bridge the gap and provide equal opportunities for students in these underserved areas. By sponsoring the salary of a teacher, the project sought to address the shortage of qualified educators and ensure consistent and uninterrupted education for children in rural schools

We met the students and checked their progress during our visit to Palghar. Every month a salary of 3300 Rs was credited to the teacher educating them. A total of 19,800 has been contributed with the help of sponsors. The salary up to the month of June has been paid and we will continue the initiative in next academic year as well.

Through the Friday-to-Friday lessons we aimed to empower and equip our interactors with essential language skills and effective communication techniques. A session was held every Friday as per the school's convenience. Recognizing the significance of these skills in their academic journey and future endeavours, the project aimed to provide a structured platform for learning and development. By focusing on grammar, vocabulary, formal communication, confident speaking, and punctuation, the initiative sought to instill a strong foundation in language proficiency. The intention was to enhance the student's confidence, articulation, and overall communication abilities, enabling them to effectively express themselves and succeed in various academic and real-life situations.
