Objectives of the programme

1. To provide students a better understanding of the Indian economy's development since Independence.
2. To analyse the operations of India's economy through an extensive study of its policies and budgets.

Participants

A total of 8 pairs of groups from different UG departments of the College participated in the event. A total of 28 students from different streams and classes attended the event.

Methodology

- ◆ The event was conducted offline in Room No. 31 on the fourth floor in the College.
- ◆ The event was organised on the occasion of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav. It started with the welcome address by the Head of the Economics Department, Dr. Shruti Panday followed by the address of Economics Association Secretary, Ms. Shaina Mohite. The event had three major rounds. First round was a quiz which consisted of 12 questions on the numerous concepts, schemes and policies offered by the Government. Subsequently, 5 groups advanced into the second round which was a fun crossword puzzle designed to test the basic knowledge of the participants in economics. The theme of the third round was introduced by the chairperson of Economics Association, Mr. Sampath Sambasivan. The task for the three groups that progressed to the third round was to formulate a well enumerated budget for the Indian Economy and justify their budgetary decisions through a short presentation of 7 minutes. Professors Dr. Neha Karnik and Mr. Saravanan Nadar gave their remarks about the budget round, appraising the participants of the technical details and applauding them for their good effort.

Outcome

Two teams out of three that participated in the final round were selected as the winners. The Judges assessed the ir presentations based on the soundness and economic validity of the claims made by the three teams in the budget proposals they put forth. The details of the winners are as follows:

1.First Prize - Mr. Mayur Shetty & Mr. Mohammad Siddiqui, SYBMS, SIES ASCS.

2.Second Prize - Ms. Anjali Bind & Mr. Shubham Prajapati, TYBA Economics, SIES ASCS.

Consolation prize was declared for Komal Mhatre and Mallika Amale who came third. The first two prize winners received their prizes from the Chief Guest during the Independence Day celebrations organised by the College on August 13, 2022. E-certificates were provided to all 8 teams.
