ASSESSMENT YEAR 2018-2019

The SIES Prajna Vision Centre for students with special needs was initiated with the mission to impart knowledge and education to special students in the least restricted environment. It envisioned to increase access, equity and promote inclusion amongst students with special needs to facilitate them to be a part of mainstream education.

The Centre was established in June, 1979 with 30 visually challenged students availing its facilities. Many students have been benefitted since then. The students are provided training in using computers and several software, by the Centre Coordinator and the staff. To encourage our visually challenged students to broaden their communication skills and be able to seek job opportunities, coaching is provided in English. Study notes are recorded and provided in a digital format, assistance is offered for completing their projects and class assignments, newspapers and articles of interest are read aloud to the students, arrangements are made for readers and writers for exam for the students in the centre. To ensure their academic wellbeing, the centre assigns student volunteers to the visually challenged students.

Under its aegis the centre provides guidance, counselling and additional facilities to the variously challenged students. Our aim is to empower and enable them to be self-reliant individuals and live life with high self-esteem.

The Centre caters to the need of the following:

- Visually Challenged Students
- Students with Learning Disabilities like - Dyslexia, Dysgraphia, Dyscalculia
- Students with maladjustment problems / emotional crisis

The centre is grateful to the following agencies, sponsors and philanthropists:

- Sion Senior Citizens Association

Several activities are conducted by the Centre for the academic development of the students with special needs. Some of the activities are as follows:

1. Readers and scribes are made available.
2. Braille Texts are purchased from the National Association of blind and made available to the students.
3. Free meals are provided by the SIES management throughout the year

4. CDs of recorded notes and text are provided to the students.
5. Special Staff committee is appointed as trainer-cum-caretaker.
6. Extra lectures and training sessions are conducted.
7. Regular interactive meetings with the Principal are held.

Apart from academic development, the centre takes into account the holistic development of the students by arranging following programs:

- Remedial English lectures to improve their English.
- Career counselling to provide them with knowledge of various career avenues.
- Personal Counselling in order to help them overcome their personal difficulties.
- Students are trained to use computers and basic word processing software.
- Interaction sessions with other visually challenged students as well as visually challenged persons who are well-placed in different careers are arranged to motivate the present students.
- Alumni meet to encourage the present students.
- To provide amenities for the visually challenged students so that they can be at par with other normal children (Inclusive education).
- Training in Meditation techniques to increase concentration and to live a stress-free life.

The centre thus ensures barrier free education to the students with special needs creating conducive environment for their overall growth and transform their disabilities into strengths and opportunities.
