The Universities/Colleges/Institutions shall update the information in the master data (regarding monthly payment confirmation, HRA, up-gradation, resignation etc.) of the beneficiaries on monthly basis. Based on the data updated on UGC web portal by the concerned Universities/Colleges/Institutions, the payment of the fellowship will be made to the beneficiaries (Detailed process available at https://www.ugc.ac.in/ugc_notices.aspx?id=2153).
